

Our composting courses have restarted!



We are happy to inform you that we have restarted our composting courses. Our aim is to invite the public to keep its green waste instead of putting it in the garbage bin, destination Mare Chicose. In Mauritius, about two thirds of household waste is green waste.

With these leaves, vegetable peelings, cut grass etc., every household, whether residing in a house or in a flat, can produce its compost, in order to keep the plants healthy: ferns, flowers, vegetables...

This activity is done in collaboration with the association Le Velo Vert, and we would like to thank them for their help, as we benefit from their office space, garden and compost heap!

The courses are for pupils, students, business staff, and individuals... with the aim of giving everyone the desire to use their green waste and have their own organic vegetable garden at home.

New models of recycling bins

We recently developed an improved version of our “twin bins” (photo on the right). Each bin is now larger, allowing to stock more recyclable waste, and with more space on the outside for information stickers. We have also developed a new big bin, 4m long and 1m40 wide, the first of which has just been placed at Super U Grand Bay.

Our presence in the Curepipe region



Mission Verte being an association whose premises are located in Curepipe, we naturally wish to add more recycle bins there and organise more educational sessions, to increase participation in the life of this city and its suburbs.

For this purpose, we are happy to be associated to the Velo Vert, another association in Curepipe, for our home composting educative sessions. We also met the Municipal Council concerning the sorting of waste and will soon put bins at Trou aux Cerfs and in front of the Municipality's building, for plastics and cans. We will also sensitize students from schools.

Going further against plastic

We warmly welcomed the year 2016 with the ban on plastic bags in supermarkets being implemented. Together let's go further: we need to pass the message that plastic should no longer be thrown into the environment, utilization of plastic containers used only once should be reduced: bottles, jars, wrappings, polystyrene. Alternatives must be found.

Sorting at Riche Terre

A plot of land has been lent to us at Riche Terre since last year, with the aim of welcoming our glass recycling project, among others. While we wait for the project to start, as we need more funding for that, we store glass and plastic there. This place will have a glass recycling workshop, recyclable waste storage and a composting area.
